GLOSSARY OF TERMS FOR SACRISTANS

| Term | Explanation |

| Alb | The white undergarment worn by the priest or acolytes |
| Altar | the appropriate term for the table around which we gather to celebrate the Eucharist |
| Ambo | The appropriate term for the podium from which the Word is proclaimed. |
| Boat | Small metal container with cover, used to hold incense; comes with a small spoon |
| Book of Gospels | Book containing Sunday Gospels for all three cycles of the year |
| Book of Gospels | Used to hold the Book of Gospels on the Altar during |
| bookholder | the first part of Mass |
| Candle Lighter | Metal rod that holds a taper used to light candles |
| Chalice | appropriate term for the vessel used to consecrate the Blood of Christ. |
| Chasuble | The outer garment worn by the priest on Sundays |
| Cincture | The rope-like cord sometimes worn around the waist by the priest |
| Corporal | Square linen cloth used on the altar underneath the chalice and paten during the Eucharistic Prayer |
| Credence Table | The small table to the left of the altar when facing the pews; it holds materials for Mass |
| Cruet | The small pitcher (with cover) that holds the wine for Mass |
| Host | the unleavened flat bread which we use in addition to the homemade unleavened bread |
| Hymn Board | Used to list the hymns for Mass |
| Incense bowl | A bowl filled with sand used to burn incense |
| Lectionary | Book containing readings used during Mass |
| Paschal Candle | The tall candle with the year inscribed on it – it is blessed at the Easter Vigil each year; used during the Easter season and for Baptisms, Funerals and Weddings |
| Purificator | Rectangular linen folded in three, used to wipe chalice during and after communion |
| Sacramentary | The book containing all the prayers for Mass |
| Sanctuary Lamp | The candle which burns constantly near the fountain; |
| Stole | The long strip of cloth worn by the priest over the shoulders (deacons wear them over one shoulder and across the body |
| Thurible | Metal pot on a long chain used for burning incense; there are 2, ,one with single chain, one with multiple chains |
| Vestments | Garments used during liturgical rites |
| Water Pitcher | Small pitcher (no cover) |
