**GATHERING FOR MASS IN PERSON INDOORS
BEGINNING JUNE 19TH FORWARD**

Beginning with the Ordination Celebration on June 19th, we will gather for Mass indoors as we used to. Masks and social distancing are optional for all who are vaccinated. We will be allowed to sing indoors with masks on. St. Peter's reopening committee is monitoring covid numbers and if the numbers remain as they are, this will be the plan going forward. We will do our best to live stream every Mass online. Details will go out on the Friday night before.

WHAT TO BRING:

- A small piece of bread in a baggie for communion; a printed copy of the worship aid (available as it has been on the Member Menu Page on the Friday night before); a face mask.

WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU ARRIVE:

- Go to the sign in desk, which will be in the narthex as you enter, and they will check you in; then ushers will be available to help you find a seat or to answer any questions.

FACE MASKS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING:

- If you are fully vaccinated face masks and social distancing are optional. **Please bring a mask to wear if you plan to join in the singing.** Seating for those fully vaccinated is on the left-hand side (facing the altar) and on the front half of the right-hand side.
- If you are not fully vaccinated (or prefer to wear a mask and social distance) seating with distance is available on the back half of the right-hand side.

SINGING:

- We will be using recorded music for now. You may sing along, but **if you choose to sing you must put on your face mask while singing.**

SIGN OF PEACE:

- We will wave a sign of peace to one another from our seats. For now, we are still minimizing movement while we are all gathered in the space.

COMMUNION:

- The bread you bring with you will be consecrated by the priest during the Eucharistic Prayer. You will be invited to partake of communion at the usual time at your seat.

REST ROOMS:

- The regular rest rooms are available. There will be a spray bottle of sanitizer in each restroom, and you are asked to spray the surface of any area you have touched.
