Parishioners came together last weekend for our Annual Discernment Meeting. Based on the sharing of our prayer and the discernment of common threads, the statement for 2019 is:

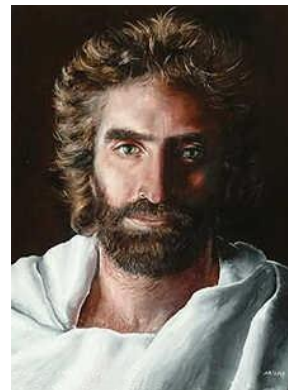
