

**GATHERING FOR MASS IN PERSON INDOORS
EVERY SATURDAY AT 4PM
LIVE STREAMED EACH WEEK
(No updates as of 9/18/21)**

We gather in person for Mass on Saturdays at 4pm; it will also be live streamed for viewing online. Check back to this page for updates each week (any updates will be highlighted in yellow below)

Masks are now required to be worn by both vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals indoors. Unvaccinated individuals must also practice social distancing.

WHAT TO BRING:

- If you do not wish to come forward to receive a consecrated host for communion, then bring a small piece of bread in a baggie for communion. It will be consecrated during the Eucharist Prayer, and you may receive at your seat. Hymnals will now be available. If you prefer not to use a hymnal, then bring a printed copy of the worship aid (available as it has been on the Member Menu Page on the Friday night before).

WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU ARRIVE:

- Go to the sign in desk, which will be in the narthex as you enter, and they will check you in; then ushers will be available to help you find a seat or to answer any questions.

FACE MASKS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING:

- Masks are required to be worn indoors at St. Peter's by both vaccinated and unvaccinated people.
- Seating for those fully vaccinated is open.
- If you are not fully vaccinated social distancing is required. Seating with distance is available at the back of the right-hand side.

SINGING:

- We will be using recorded music for now and you may sing along as we always have.

SIGN OF PEACE:

- We will wave a sign of peace to one another from our seats. For now, we are still minimizing movement while we are all gathered in the space.

COMMUNION:

- We are currently distributing communion in the form of bread only. It will be a host enclosed in a small plastic bag and will be placed in your hand as you come forward at communion time. If you do not wish to come forward to receive communion, bring a small piece of bread with you as you have been doing.

REST ROOMS:

- The regular rest rooms are available. There will be a spray bottle of sanitizer in each restroom, and you are asked to spray the surface of any area you have touched.
